Page 13. The Burnett homestead in Fire Place (now Brookhaven), NY is at 321 Beaver Dam Road, not "Burnett Lane, off Beaver Dam Road." [Burnett Lane extends south off Beaver Dam Road nearly opposite the homestead. It likely was originally a farm lane which may have defined the western edge of a farm lot on the south side of Beaver Dam Rd. It is said that there originally was a barn at the southeast corner of the two roads, which burned many years ago. JD]

Page 13. 'We do not know where he is buried, possibly in Woodland Cemetery.' He is buried at Woodland Cemetery, as I just came across a copy of the cemetery plot deed in an old box of papers belonging to his grand daughter, Ann. Frances Jagger Burnett purchased a large plot #227 and being 28ft. by 28ft 6in containing 798 superficial ft. We know that Frances and Geo. H. Burnett are buried there and there is a good chance that Geo. H. Jr., Isaac and Henry Theron (also never married) plus Ann Frances, and Frances White Hand. Thomas Jefferson Burnett is buried in the Flushing Cemetery, Flushing NY.

#### WILL OF THOMAS BURNETT

In the name of God, Amen, I, Thomas Burnet, of Southampton, in ye east Rideing of yorksheire on LongIsland, Husbandman, being sicke of body but through ye mercy of god, in perfect Strength of memory, blessed be his name, for it and not knowing the day of my Death doe make this my will and Testament in manner and forme following:

Imprimis, I give and bequeath my Soule to Christ, my redeamer, who by His blood hath purchased the same.

2ndly I give my body to ye Earth from whence it was first taken After a decent buryall to be made by my Exacutrix and for my wordly Estate I give it as hereafter mentioned.

3dly I give unto my six children, John, Joell, Lott, Hester, Merriam, Precilla, each of them five shillings a peice to be paid to them by my Executrix.

4ly I give unto my son, Aaron Burnett, my house and home lott after my wifes Deceas and my three Acres on ye ten Acre lotts and at my Deceas I give unto him my said son my ten Acres lying at Meacoks Adjoyning to ye Land of Mr. Jonah ffordham and all my ox=pasture divition, and two heifers and two Steers, to be Delivered to him by my Executrix.

5ly I give unto my two sons Mordecay and Dan Burnet all my Land att a placw Called Cormorants point to be Equally Devided between them When they shall Ataine to ye Age of one and twenty years only they Shall Sumer six cowes for my wife Dureing her Life.

6ly: I give unto my Son Matthias After my Said wives Decease my Cloas In ye great plaines in halseyes neck.

7ly: I give unto my Daughter Lois at her Day of Marriage, or att ye age of Eighteen which shall first happen the Sum of ten pounds to be paid unto her by my executrix.

Lastly I by this my Last will and testament make my Loveing wife Mary Burnet Sole Executrix of this my Last will and Testament and to have all ye Residue of my Estate that is not Disposed and to pay all my Debts and Legacies herein mentioned.

In witness whereof I have here unto Sett my hand and Seale this the 16th day of March Ano: Dom 1679-80.

Notes for MARY UNKNOWN:

In "The Early History of Southampton with Genealogies", George Rogers Howell, 1887, on page 206 states: "1. Thomas d. about 1684 had first w. Mary and second w. Mary Pierson prob. d. of John Pierson of Lynn m. in Lynn Dec. 3, 1663...This conclusion on the part of the author appears to be in error.

While it is not known who the family of Mary Pierson (or Pearson) was, she was not the Mary Pierson, daughter of John Pierson of Lynn, Massachusetts, who was married on December 3, 1663 to a Thomas Burnap (inadvertently listed as Thomas BURNITT in the Lynn Vital Records). The children of Thomas Burnap and Mary Pierson were: Thomas, Ebenezer, Mary Bethia, Sarah, Annah, Bethia and Esther. Thomas Bernap (the younger) died in Reading, MA in 1791. Research by Sam Behling.

Research by Jim Fina: Presently focusing on Mary Pierson being the Step-daughter of John Cooper of Southampton. Sister of Henry Pierson, Thomas Cooper, John Cooper, and 2 other daughters of John Cooper, Sr. There is no mention of her in John Cooper's will - but in another document there is mention of a bed held for her by her brother. In some way she angered her father enough to disinherit her completely.

#### LAST WILL & TESTAMENT OF LOT BURNET

In ye name of God Amen, the sixth day of June in ye year of our Lord God 1702 I Lot Burnat, of ye town of S'hampton in ye County of Suffolk & province of New York, Cordwainer, being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God therefor, calling to mind ye mortality of my body & knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this to be my last will & testamt. that is to say, principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into ye hands of God that gave it & for my body I recommend to ye earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner at ye discretion of my Executors - And as touching such wordly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give and devise & dispose of ye same in ye following manner & form - Imp(mis) I give & bequeath to my wife Phebe during her natural life one half of all my housing and lands meadows & orchards yt I have in ye bounds of ye town of S'hampton aforesd & ye one half of my moveable estate of w(t) nature or kind or whatsoever to be found in ye sd County of Suffolk forever - And I give & bequeath to my eldest son Joseph ye one half of all my land housing & barn & orchard & meadow yt I have in ye bounds of S'hampton forever & at his mothers decease all ye other half of sd land housing & barn in ye bounds of S'hampt. afores(d) the half of my orchard Excepted which I have hereafter given to my son David Burnat to his heirs & assigns forever ye above named moiety or half of my orchard at his mothers decease & all that my certain house & accommodate of land & meadow at a place commonly known by ye name of Cohansey in ye bounds of ye town of Fairfield in ye Province of West Jersey in America. Imp(mis) I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Fithian ye sum of 10 shill having rec(d) her part before, Item - I give & bequeath unto my six sons namely Joseph David Jonathan Nathan Ephraim & Samuel Burnat all ye rest of my estate not above demised & given & disposed to be equally divided amongst my sd six sons each of them to receive of my Executors ye equal six part of all my estate not demised & given as afores(d). Item - I make constitute & ordain my beloved wife Phebe & my eldest son Joseph Burnat my Executors of this my last will & testmt to fulfil & Execute this my last Will & testamt. according to tenor & form of it & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all & every other former testamts wills legacys bequests & Executors by me in any ways before this time named willed & bequeathed ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & testmt. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal ye day & year above written.

Notes for GEORGE HUBERT BURNETT:

Sailed on an old whaling ship purchased solely to go to the gold rush in California. A series of letters from Albert Jagger to his wife tells of going around the Cape and their mining of gold in San Francisco and Sacramento, CA. The ship was the Sabrina - the letters were from 3/29/1849 thru 10/5/1851. The Sabrina was a whaler, owned by Charles T. During, Captained by Capt. Vali, 416 tonnage, sailed the NW Coast. Sold in 1847 to the Southampton-California Mining & Trading Co.

From "Water Mill, the history of a Long Island Town, 1644-1994"; 'An old whaling ship came in handy in 1849 when news of the California Gold Rush reached the East End. A group of 60 men, including some from Water Mill, decided to seek their fortunes and formed the Southampton-California Mining and Trading Co.. They purchased the Sabrina, an old whaling ship, issued stock certificates, and set off. Many of these men died in California. Those that returned came home with adventurous tales but little gold.'

George H. had his first dig in Deer Creek then 15 miles away at Bear Creek. His last dig known was at Feather River.

George Hubert was quite successful in the gold fields and returned home to marry Frances Mary Jagger. She did not want to return West, so he built a farm (107+acres) in Brookhaven on Burnett Lane off Beaver Dam Road, then called 'Fireplace'. George Hubert on April 8, 1871 was appointed as Overseer of Highways by the Town of Brookhaven in the County of Suffolk, to serve in and for the Road Districts until the next town meeting or till others are appointed. He also served in this position October 3, 1876 and October 9, 1879.

He was a farmer and died of cronic Bright's Disease.  
We do not know where he is buried, possibly in Woodland Cemetery.

From a letter from the present owner of 325 Beaver Dam Road - Mrs. Karen Rowley.

".....We would have loved showing you the house, which we don't think has changed much in all these years, except of course plumbing, heating & and obviously an improved kitchen." ".....Our information was that relatives of his lived in this house until sometime in the 40's." "...I know that one of them was a Miss Hand, who at the time we bought the house (1961) worked at the Post Office here in Brookhaven. She was rather elderly then, or at least I thought so, and unfortunately I didn't ask her much about herself or her family. Such a pity! She is now dead." "...We also had understood that these relatives had come upon hard times, and that Oliver Wellington had bought this house at a tax sale - perhaps sometime in the early 30s - and that he let these relatives

live here until they died." ".....One of our babysitters I had when the children were young (a Mrs. Valzora Murdock Barry) remembered coming here with her pail for milk, from the milk shed, which is now attached to the back of the house by a little breeze way." ".....One outhouse is still back in the woods. And we are aware that there had been a barn at some time, as the burnt locust posts and some stones are back at the edge of the woods."

Notes for FRANCES MARY JAGGER:

Per Aunt Ann Parker 1987 - "I could not remember the old lady that she did not scare me with her cock and parrot and SELF! She was always saying, "Don't you touch that Anna Burnett!!" She was Frances Jaggar who married George Hubert Burnett after his 3 whale expos and his staking out gold claims in Sacramento - but she would not go west with her young man, so he bought the farm in Brookhaven, sprang from the Hamptons...tho she was supposed to be most beautiful and a wonderful dancer there, she looked like a scary old witch to me,,and I can see how I am on the same unprimrose path!!!!"

Obituary: Tuesday, April 15, 1924 Mrs. Frances M. Burnett

"Mrs. Frances M. Burnett, widow of George Burnett, died Tuesday at the home of her son, Isaac Burnett, in Brookhaven, being 97 years old. Despite her great age she was until very recently an active woman and was a familiar figure to passerbys working in her garden on Beaver Dam Road. The funeral is to be held this afternoon at 2 o'clock from the house with service in charge of the Rev. Frederick E. Allen and interment in the Woodland Cemetery, Bellport."

Mrs. Burnett was born at Westhampton October 10, 1826, daughter of Enoch (Jagger) and Phebe Conklin. She made her home in Brookhaven many years. She leaves four sons, Isaac, Hubert, and Theron of Brookhaven and Jefferson of Flushing and a daughter, Mrs. Hand of Bridgehampton."

Letter from Karen Rowley, who presently lives in the Burnett farmstead in Brookhaven, L.I., NY.

Dated Aug. 2, 1999.

"...I did talk with Bob Starke today, due to a passing remark from a friend who suggested that Bob used to work for Theron. Sure enough, that was true. Bob is a very nice gentleman who lived in Brookhaven until he was in 3rd grade, then went to Brooklyn, then came back to Brookhaven and has stayed forever. He was born in 1916. He worked for Theron for awhile (I don't know exactly when), and said that Theron and Ike (Isaac) both batchelors, lived in this house with a maid, a Miss Green. He remembers when there was no electricity here, but later on the house was electrified. He also remembers the barn that used to be here. He said they raised Holsteins and put up hay. Theron was a bay man, and Bob worked for him for 50 cents a day. Theron fished and crabbed and had eel pots. Bob said he was busy year round. Bob also said that he was the last bayman on this bay without a motor. He thinks they both lived here until they died. He like Theron alot...kept saying he was quite a guy..."

Notes for THOMAS JEFFERSON BURNETT:

"Thomas Jefferson Burnett bought into the Roger's firm of Providers. It was named Robbins & Burnett and was located in Bayshore L.I. near Bayshore Ave. on Main Street (later Montauk Hwy.) They owned 5 teams.



TJ was winning customers and apparently knew the finality of the partnership (he also refused to marry their sister - who did not have all her wits.) They separated and TJ set up his own business and he called on the 'summer people, Irwins' he had 5 teams to plow the grounds. and here met Elizabeth N. Irwin. Ironically, Anna Maria Irwin said, 'TJB may be a farmer but he is too smart to die poor!' Eliz. Irwin said he was the sweetest thing to come down the pike, curly blond hair and china blue eyes he had to his death." (from a letter written by an Irwin in the early 1900s.)

T.J. married Elizabeth Noble Irwin. He became an active real estate broker in Flushing NY. Owned property in Bayshore - the Burnett Marina on Great South Bay, and the house at 12 Burnett Avenue just up from the marina. George spent his summers at this house. TJ also owned 'Burnett Court', an apt. building on Sanford Ave. & Main St., Flushing, NY plus the Flushing Swimming Pool.

Thomas Jefferson formed the Thomas Jefferson Burnett Inc. in 1931. The office was at 90-04 161st Street, Jamaica, Queens. The Directors being: Thomas J. Burnett, Pres; Jessie E Ellis, secretary and George I Burnett, Sr., Vice President. In 1939, the office moved to 41-31 Main Street, Flushing, NY. In 1940 Anne C. (Burnett)Parker was made Treasurer. He always helped support his family in Brookhaven until he passed away in 1940. The homestead was then sold for back taxes to Oliver Wellington. It is now ( 1999) owned by Karen Rowley and her husband and lovingly restored to its original beauty.

With the combination of his beloved wife's death and the effects of the 1929 stock market crash, he lost all of his holdings. He lived with his son and daughter-in-law in Lakeville, CT in his waning years.

He was active in the affairs of St. Johns & St. Georges Episcopal Churches in Flushing. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a life member of the Cornucopia Lodge in Flushing NY, and a charter member of the Bay Shore Yacht Club. He is buried in Flushing cemetery....163-06 46th Avenue, Flushing NY 11358 - Grave 4, Plot 19, Division B, Section 14. Phone #FL 9-0100(old).
